Reflection

During these weeks after Easter we have been hearing of many appearances of the risen Jesus. Like the disciples, our responses to these appearances may happen on many different levels: some of us may feel sympathy with the group of disciples who could not believe the women; some may connect with Thomas who refused to believe unless he saw for himself; some may identify with the two going to Emmaus who did not recognize Jesus until quite late in the journey.

Today, we hear that Jesus is now firmly and clearly leaving their physical presence. There will be no more appearances - and it is only then that they will be able to "receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you". They will begin to develop a very different way of "seeing", because the Holy Spirit will give them "wisdom and revelation...with the eyes of your heart enlightened".

It is the same for us. The Feast of the Ascension marks a time of preparation, of longing, to receive the amazing release of the Holy Spirit - the very Spirit of Jesus himself. Let us prepare our hearts and minds for this most precious of God's gifts, wanting to be poured out into every one of us - both as individuals, and as a Christian community.

While Christ is with us in spirit, we are now the hands and feet of Christ in our world. It is we who must go out and proclaim Christ to the ends of the earth. It is through us that people will meet the Risen Christ.
