

19th Sunday in Ordinary Time His Voice that speaks of Peace 9 August 2020

Reflection

Peter answered him and said, "Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the waters." He said, "Come!" Peter stepped down from the boat and walked on the waters to come to Jesus. But when he saw that the wind was strong, he was afraid, and beginning to sink, he cried out, saying, "Lord, save me!" Immediately Jesus stretched out his hand, took hold of him, and said to him, "You of little faith, why did you doubt?"

In today's Gospel, Jesus appears to the disciples while walking toward them on the water. Through the chaos that the apostles were experiencing through the rough storms, they did not believe it was him, insisting in terror that the figure in front of them was a ghost.

Despite their disbelief and disorder, "Jesus called out to them, saying, 'Courage! It's me! Do not be afraid."

He meets them where they are, in the storm, in their troubles, in their turmoil. He assures the apostles that He is right alongside them, while they might not see it at first, He was there all along. Jesus was not going to abandon them, nor was He going to let the rough weather cause any harm unto them.

Here, Jesus is reminding us to have courage, to trust that He is right beside us in all the chaos and the struggles we encounter in life. We often question His presence, when things don't go to *our* plan, we have a tendency to conclude that Jesus had deserted us. But we must have courage, for He will never forsake us. We must not be afraid.

Jesus then calms the sea, His power over the raging waters showing the lengths He would go to in order to protect His people. Jesus' love for us is infinite; there is nothing He wouldn't do to protect us.

Finally, He brings Peter onto the water, He walks with him despite how impossible the action may seem. We see that with Christ, all is feasible. When we hit a roadblock and feel like nothing is going right, we must have courage and have faith in Him. For the impossible is possible if we accept the hand Jesus is holding out for us.

And much like Peter, we can walk on water with Him.
