# 29<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time The Lord of History

18th October 2020

Mission Sunday

### Reflection

It is actually quite ironic in relation to our current day elections, as held this weekend and electing a party and hence leader.... that in today's first reading Isaiah reminds Israel, that the Lord rules not only over them but over all nations and is the only God. These claims must have seemed absurd to his hearers because in their day a god's rank is reckoned by the nation-status of its people compared to others. The biblical Prophets insist that the Babylonians are merely the instrument the Lord uses to punish Israel for its infidelity.

In our Second Reading today this letter written in AD50-51, is the earliest writing in the New Testament. Paul reminds the Thessalonians to claim the Gospel and how Baptism can expand their existence. These individual lives are now intertwined in Christ, in with the members of their communities as well as other Christian communities, and their gifts are faith, love, and hope. These gifts require effort. Faith must be demonstrated by action; labour is a love which is often inconvenient and fraught with difficulties. The hope that Christ lives and will return needs constant nourishment.

In the parables from the GOSPEL past three Sundays, Jesus tells the religious leaders that they are in danger of losing the Kingdom of God. Angered by his warning, the Pharisees plot to trap him in speech and discredit him. For me, the key words of the Gospel here are where Jesus after receiving the coin says give to Caesar what is his and to God his...the things of God—that's what Jesus knows and wants to talk about. There are some key similarities in the readings and Gospel today which can be referenced to making the right decisions for our country by our modern-day leadership and our elected Government.

Have a blessed week St Marks Community of Pakuranga as we pray for our elected Government leaders that they can make the right decisions for our beautiful country of Aotearoa New Zealand.
