# 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in Advent *The Good News* 6<sup>th</sup> December 2020

## Reflection

Our readings today remind us of the good news God brings us.

Mark's gospel begins: *"The beginning of the Good News about Jesus Christ, the Son of God"*. The word gospel means good news. The good news that God loves us passionately, no matter what we may or may not <u>*do*</u>, but because of who we <u>*are*</u>: God's own precious, beloved, holy, and sacred children, made by God in God's own image and likeness.

Mark reminds us that God has come down from heaven to be with his people, to comfort us, heal us, feed us, teach us, and to save us. This is the astonishingly good news of Christmas.

The prophet Isaiah reminds us in beautiful poetry that God wants to console and comfort us "*like a shepherd feeding his flock, gathering lambs in his arms, holding them against his breast*". Isaiah gives us a beautiful image of God building a highway for his people across the barren and dangerous deserts, filling up the deep valleys and leveling down the steep mountains. To make it easy for his people to come home.

Our Christian faith should always be good news, and if it is not good news, if it is judgmental, unkind, or unloving, then we have got it very wrong.

In the gospel, John the Baptist begins his mission to prepare the way for Jesus. This is also our own mission, to prepare the way for Jesus to come into the lives of others. John does this by encouraging people to turn away from greed and violence and to share with those in need.

In 1981, the US Catholic Bishops called us to apply this in our own lives:

"Because we believe in the dignity of the person, we must embrace every chance to help and to liberate, to heal the wounded world as Jesus taught us. Our hands must be the strong but gentle hands of Christ, reaching out in mercy and justice, touching individual persons, but also touching the social conditions that hinder the wholeness which is God's desire for humanity."

Let us pray for the grace to continue doing that as missionary disciples, empowered by the Holy Spirit to bring the love and joy of Christ to others.
