1<sup>ST</sup> Reading: Acts 4: 8-12. 17-19 This is the only name by which we can be saved.

Psalm: 117: 1.8-9.21-23.26.28-29 The stone which the builders rejected has become the corner stone.

**2<sup>ND</sup> Reading**: John 3: 1-2 We shall see God as he really is.

Gospel: John 10: 11-18 The good shepherd is one who lays down his life for his sheep.

### Reflection

In today's Gospel reading, we are called to understand Jesus' role as a good shepherd and His self-sacrificing love for us all. His love goes beyond the type of emotion that we can comprehend, surpassing our humanly love which is fickle and wavering, from pain and disappointment. He teaches us of a love that rises above self-centredness, to reach the hearts of each and every person around us.

So, what is the role of a shepherd that we so often hear Jesus being referred to?

It is someone who guides and leads, it is a protector, a nourisher, a companion, and a welcomer. Let us challenge ourselves to be a shepherd to someone in our own lives this week.

Can we show patience when someone comes to us for help? Can we stand up for someone who's facing an injustice? Can we provide a meal for someone who may be in need? Can we listen deeply if someone feels troubled? Can we welcome someone who may feel out of place?

With small actions of selfless love that show we care, we become more like a good shepherd and less like the hired hand, leading us closer to Jesus day by day.






