Christ The True Vine

28 April 2024

1ST Reading: Acts 9: 26-31 Barnabas explained how the Lord had appeared to Saul on his journey.

Psalm: 21: 26-28. 30-32 You, Lord, are my praise in the great assembly.

2ND Reading: John 3: 18-24 His commandments are these: that we believe in His Son and that we love one another.

Gospel: John 15: 1-8 Whoever remains in me, with me in him, bears fruit in plenty.

<u>Reflection</u>

In today's Gospel, Jesus says that he is the true vine, and that God is the vine grower. When applying this to our lives, we are the branches. As human beings, we were all created by God. I find it easier to understand if we imagine a fruit tree. God planted the seed, nurtured it and watered the tree. He gave it life, just as he gave us life. The root of the tree and its foundation is Jesus. He is the connection from the heavens to the earth and from him we can see God in the flesh.

As branches of the tree, our purpose is to bear fruit. Now not all of the branches will serve their purpose, and some will have to be pruned. As I wrote this reflection, I wanted to understand why we prune trees.

The definition on Google states that the reason why is because dead branches hinder the growth of healthy components. God, our vine grower, is removing all the negativity from our lives because he wants us to grow and live fruitful lives without being affected by 'dead branches' and people/influences that will prevent us from serving our true purpose – to bear fruit.

To bear fruit is to share the good news. This can be taken in the literal context as preaching the Word of the Lord to those we meet but it can also be something as simple as spreading love and positivity to those around us. What Jesus says to his disciples is that the only way to God is through him. If we follow God he will be in us and work through us. And even though we can still live our lives without our faith, it wouldn't nearly be as good as if we had God by our side.




